LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 4 OF 2003

### SPEED OF VESSELS

Mariners are reminded of the requirements of Langstone Harbour Byelaws Nos.5 & 6 as follows:

#### 5. Vessels to navigate with care

**The Master shall navigate his vessel with such care and caution and at such speed and in such manner as not to endanger the lives of or cause injury to persons or damage to property and as not to obstruct the navigation, manoeuvring, loading or discharging of vessels or moorings or other property.**

#### 6. Speed of Vessels

**Except with the permission of the Harbour Master and, subject to Byelaw 5 and the Collision Regulations, the Master of a vessel shall not cause or permit the vessel to proceed over the ground (a) at a speed greater than 10 knots or (b) in the Langstone Marina approach channel, at a speed greater than 5 knots.**

In complying with the requirements of Byelaws 5 & 6, vessels should be careful not to generate wake or wash which may cause damage or inconvenience to other craft. This is particularly important in the Marina Channel where small craft are moored in very shallow water adjacent to the Channel.
