LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 14 OF 2007

LOADED VESSELS IN HARBOUR APPROACHES

Mariners are advised that loaded merchant vessels operating in the approaches to Langstone Harbour between the Fairway Pile LF1.10s and the Langstone Pilot Boarding place (50° 44.8'N, 01° 01.4'W) may be constrained by their draught. Such vessels will display the signals prescribed in Rule 28 of the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, 1972.

The approaches to Langstone Harbour lie within the Dockyard Port of Portsmouth and the following Local Notices to Mariners refer:
