LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 4 OF 2010

VESSEL WASH

1. Mariners are reminded that wash caused by vessels, even at speeds lower than the Harbour speed limit, can result in damage or injury to vessels and other Harbour users in shallow water. Langstone Harbour Byelaw No.5 requires vessels to be navigated with care as follows:

Vessels to navigate with care

The Master shall navigate his vessel with such care and caution and at such speed and in such manner as not to endanger the lives of or cause injury to persons or damage to property and as not to obstruct the navigation, manoeuvring, loading or discharging of vessels or moorings or other property.

2. A reduction in speed is always an effective way of reducing or eliminating wash. All vessels are reminded to have regard to the safety of harbour users in the inshore zone.
