



# Recycling Scheme for boat waste

**Langstone Harbour Board now has recycling facilities available for harbour users to reduce the amount of waste that is sent to landfill from their boat.**

The scheme has been designed to make it easy to recycle boat generated waste by having just one container to take mixed recycling. This means waste need only be separated into two bags; mixed recycling and general waste.

Recycling can then be disposed of in the designated green bin which is clearly marked, and general waste disposed of in the correct purple bins alongside the recycling bin.

Please note that these facilities are available to harbour users during office hours only.

## Cans and metals



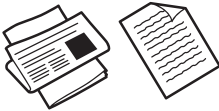
Drinks cans, tinned food cans, aluminium trays and foil.

## Plastics



Plastic bottles, cups, sandwich boxes, milk cartons etc.

## Paper



Plain paper, newspaper, magazines and wrapping paper.

## Glass



Glass bottles (green, clear and brown) jars etc.

## Cardboard



Cardboard, corrugated packaging and fast food boxes etc.
