

Hazardous waste disposal

Langstone Harbour Board now has waste disposal facilities for waste oil, oily rags and oil filters.

These materials are classified as hazardous waste and under the new

Hazardous Waste Regulations it is illegal to mix hazardous materials together or mix them with non hazardous waste. There is a fixed penalty of £300 per offence for minor offences.



Please help by disposing of your waste responsibly by using the correct drums marked 'Oil filters' or 'Cloths (oil contaminated)' which can be found next to the slipway in the LHB yard.

Other waste can then be separated into recyclable and non-recyclable and disposed of in the designated green recycling bin which is clearly marked, or the purple general waste bins.

Please note that we cannot take empty oil containers, antifouling paint products, varnish, batteries, fibreglass or other hazardous materials. You should contact the local household waste and recycling centre to see if they accept this waste on 023 9246 2566.

These facilities are available to harbour users during office hours only.
