COVID-19: GUIDANCE ON BOATING

DEFRA have today published 'Guidance on Inland and Coastal Boating and protecting yourself and others from coronavirus'.

The Guidance applies both to boats used for leisure & recreation and boats in commercial use. The new guidance is built largely on existing Government advice to limit contact with other people and maintain physical separation of 2 metres. It contains the following provisions:

- You must not stay overnight on any boat, unless it's your primary residence.
- Skippered day boat hire or skippered day charter boat hire is not permitted.
- Tourist and trip boat operators must remain closed.

Previously issued Covid-19 Guidance still applies as follows:

- Stay at home as much as possible
- Work from home if you can
- Limit contact with other people
- Keep your distance if you go out (2 metres apart where possible)
- Wash your hands regularly
- Do not leave home if you or anyone in your household has symptoms
