PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 06 OF 2025

Diving Operations in Langstone Harbour at Eastney Lake – Marina Channel

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that diving operations will take place in the Premier Marina Southsea approach channel on Wednesday 21st May 2025.

Works will take place to remove an obstruction in close proximity to port-hand lateral Pile 12 (N09334), Fl (4) R. 10s, in position 50° 47.700'N, 1° 2.170'W.

To ensure the safety of divers at all times, the Marina channel will be closed to all other vessels from the commencement of diving operations at approximately 0900, until completion of diving operations expected by 1400.

The Master of any other vessel wishing to access the channel from the Marina should berth at the Marina waiting pontoon and contact the Langstone Harbour Office for instructions. The Master of any vessel wishing to access the Marina channel from seaward should berth at the Eastney Ferry Pontoon and contact the Langstone Harbour Office for instructions.



Diving operations will take place from the harbour's workboat Delilah and will be indicated by **Code Flag Alpha** when divers are in the water.

Harbour staff will be keeping a watch on VHF Ch68 and may be contacted onboard Delilah for further information.

Cancel this notice on completion of diving operations, on or before 1600, 21st May 2025.
