

LANGSTONE HARBOUR PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 08 OF 2025

Bed Levelling at Kendall's Wharf

Mariners are advised that the workboat 'ERICA" will be engaged in survey and bed levelling operations at the Kendall's Wharf for a period of approximately 1 week from Monday 1st December 2025.

Dredging operations will be carried out approximately three hours either side of high-water during hours of darkness as well as by day.

The dredger will display lights and shapes as required by the International Regulations for the Prevention of Collisions at Sea and will be restricted in its ability to manoeuvre during operations. ALL OTHER CRAFT should give 'ERICA' a wide berth and monitor VHF Channel 68 for any instructions. Mariners are requested to reduce speed as safe navigation permits when passing any vessel engaged in dredging activities.



The 'ERICA' will maintain a listening watch on VHF Channel 16 and 68 throughout operations.

Completion is scheduled by Tuesday 8th December, but mariners should also note that these timings are subject to amendment as required by weather conditions and are reminded to keep a good look out until cancellation of this Notice.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
