LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 13 OF 2024

Closure of Ferry Road Slipway, Hayling Island During Repairs

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that the Ferry Road slipway at Hayling Island will be closed for essential maintenance from Monday 7th October 2024 for 4 weeks, until Friday 1st November, while a comprehensive maintenance and resurfacing works package takes place.

Slipway access on Hayling Island will be maintained at Langstone Harbour Office yard, adjacent to the Ferry Road Slipway, but will be subject to some necessary restrictions.

The Harbour Office yard slipway is tidally restricted and is unsuitable for trailer launching around 2hrs either side of low water.

The Harbour Office yard will be accessible between 0900-1700, 7 days-a-week for the duration of these works. **Anyone wishing to use the yard slipway outside these times should contact the harbour Office at least 24hrs in advance.**

Alternative public slipways remain available at Eastney ([w3w:///firmly.bottom.spots](#)) and Broadmarsh ([w3w:///rushed.eagles.inches](#)). Normal harbour charges apply to all vessels using public slipways to access Langstone Harbour (see our [schedule of charges](#) here).

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
