LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 02 OF 2024

Sunken Vessel Recovery Operations (D Area Moorings) – Submerged Hazard

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that wreck recovery operations are taking place to recover a sunken yacht at the northern end of the D area moorings.

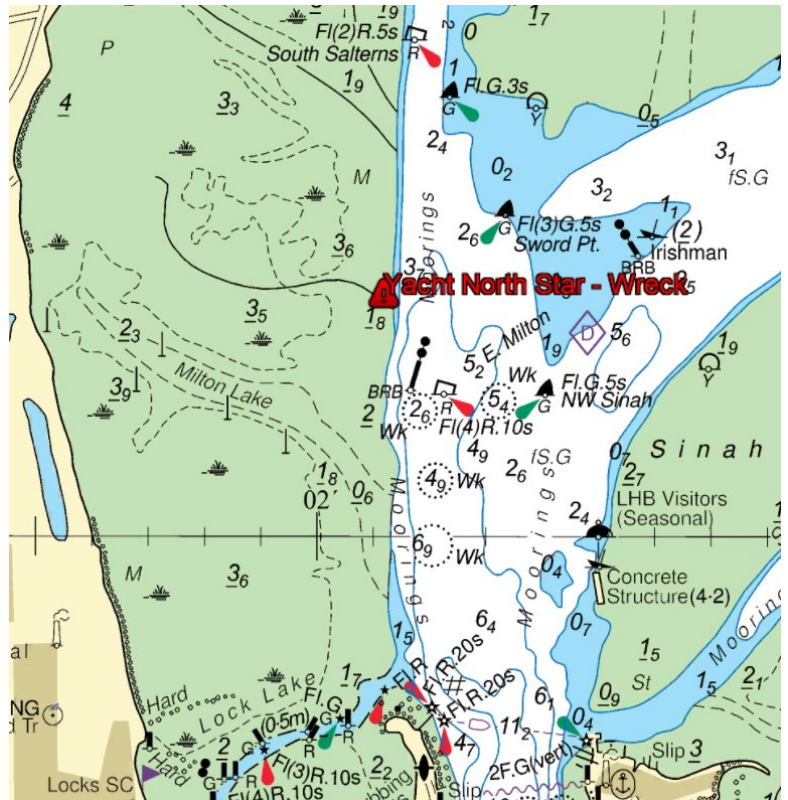
The 9.3m yacht lies 900m north of Eastney Spit, to the west of the drying line, in position:

50° 48.251'N

001° 01.888'W

and remains marked by a yellow mooring buoy and a blue barrel.

The vessel is missing its mast and is not visible at high water. Mariners should take care in the vicinity and are advised to keep 30m clear to avoid associated ropes and wires. Efforts to recover the wreck are being progressed.
