LANGSTONE HARBOUR LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 07 OF 2023

Collapse of Channel Marker Pile at Broad Lake - Bedhampton Quay and Broadmarsh Slipway Approach

Mariners are advised that following recent storm events “Pile F” (N04077) marking the line of the approach channel in Broad Lake leading to Chalk Dock Lake, Broadmarsh Slipway and the Bedhampton Quay has collapsed.

Pile F - charted position:

**50° 50.162'N
001° 0.177'W**



The pile remains a hazard to navigation and is covered at high water. Mariners are advised to keep well clear. The Broad Lake Channel continues to be navigable using remaining port-hand piles and the transit beacons at the north end of this channel.

The pile is number 5 of 6 port hand piles (running from south to north) marking the west side of the navigable channel towards Bedhampton/Broadmarsh and the K area moorings. The owner of the pile – Tarmac Trading Limited – has been informed.

Owners, Agents, Charterers, Marinas, Yacht Clubs and Recreational Sailing Organisations should ensure that the contents of this Notice are made known to the Masters or persons in charge of their vessels or craft.
