LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 07 OF 2024

**Workboat Operations – Eastern Road Bridge**

**Mariners are advised** that the multi-cat workboat *Bulldog* will be working with a 12m x 6m flat-top pontoon on the Eastern Road bridge from now for a period of approximately one month. Operators will be working from the pontoon, at height, above the water on the bridge removing redundant communications ducting from the structure.

**All vessels are to navigate with care in the vicinity of these operations and pass the works at DEAD SLOW in order to minimise any wake.**

Position of works: 50° 49.92'N, 001° 02.66'W.

The barge will be left in position on temporary sinkers overnight. At night the barge will be marked with orange flashing lights. While working the *Bulldog* will be listening on the Langstone Harbour radio frequency VHF Ch68.
