PORT NOTICE TO MARINERS NO. 02 OF 2026

**Out of Hours Access to Eastney Pontoon**

**Mariners are advised** that from April 2026 access to the Eastney Pontoon to and from shore will be restricted.

A newly installed gate on the Eastney Pontoon linkspan will now be locked overnight from the time of the last Hayling Ferry departure, until the first service in the morning.

This measure has been introduced in response to unauthorised use of the pontoon, as well as damage caused to the pontoon and life-saving equipment, outside working hours.

Vessels will still be able to moor on the pontoon outside normal working hours, however access to shore will be restricted.

Harbour users requiring access to and from shore while using the pontoon outside normal working hours should contact the harbour office at least 24hrs in advance.
