- The Water Ski licence is valid from 1 April to 31 October unless revoked by written notice. Launching and
- recovery of boats is allowed at all points of access to the harbour. However, in the Harbour, the water ski boat must proceed to the water ski area <u>at or below the 10 knot speed limit</u>. The speed limit may only be exceeded whilst water skiing.
- 3 Your licence must be produced for inspection on demand by any of the Board's authorised officers.
- 4 Water skiing is only permitted to take place between sunrise and sunset.
